Curriculum for the institute is designed to meet or exceed PASS standards and includes an address from Irving Faught, administrator of the Oklahoma Securities Commission, presenting various investment fraud schemes and how teachers, and subsequently students, can protect themselves. Teachers are eligible to incorporate the concepts from the institute in their classrooms or in organizations they sponsor in the Students Tracking and Researching the Stock Market project.
