3. At the top of the page, click the *Maps* tab.



A map opens showing **all** of the S&P 500 companies, yes, all 500.


The blue bars contain SECTOR names—Technology, Services, etc.

The yellow bars contain INDUSTRY names—Application Software, etc.

The "size" of the box for each company relates to the market cap / size of company.



4. Left column.



Click the drop down arrow to the right of *Data*.

Select the timeframe for which you want to see performance results.


The bar along the bottom with red, black, and green % and date show the performance of each company based on the timeframe.

Note the list of companies in alphabetical order along w/ticker symbols.

A *Search* box allows you to search for a specific company.

Double click a company name to open information about that company.

5. At the top of the page click the *Screener* tab. Descriptive is the default screen. Descriptive is a basic *starting* place. Other choices are Fundamental, Technical, and All. Students select preferred screen and preferred criteria. Obviously, the more criteria selected, the more narrow the list of companies.

A variety of Views are available to review information about the companies based on the selected criteria. In this example, the stocks are displayed in the *Overview* view.
